

# Preservation Alliance of West Virginia Endangered Properties Program Nominations for 2011 PAWV Endangered List

## Criteria for nominating a property

- There must be a degree of endangerment by owner neglect, proposed demolition, rezoning, redevelopment, and/or other human or environmental factors.
- The property must be listed on or eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places. Those properties eligible must additionally complete the Historic Properties Inventory form included with the document. N.R. properties can disregard the HPI form.
- There must be evidence of significant local support for preservation of the property.
- A separate application form must be submitted for each nominated property
- Selections will be made based on their significance solely as determined by the Preservation Alliance of West Virginia. The decision will be based on historic, cultural and/or architectural factors as well as feasibility, degree of local support and risk of loss.
- Properties not selected for endangered list may be placed on the 'watch list', but must be resubmitted the following year for consideration for that year's endangered list. Resubmission is required so that the most current information about the status of the site can be used in determining its endangerment.
